Project itinerary

Your week ahead will depend on what's needed at the centre, and also the beach weather conditions. Further, this programme can be hard work, as you support staff in the cleaning of the turtles, the tanks and the turtle conservation centre. However, the work itself is incredibly rewarding – and you are, of course, working with a fantastic team!

Typical daily tasks may include:

- Feeding the turtles (every other day)
- Cleaning the tanks
- Careing for the turtles
- Cleaning the beach
- Helping with the weekly release of over 100 newborn turtles into the ocean (depends on the weather and season).

Sailatalarama Vihara

This temple lies about 7 km inland from Ambalangoda, and sits on a domed hill with stunning views over spice plantations and lakes. Incidentally, the temple has a 35m-long sleeping Buddha statue which alone, is worth the effort of getting there!

The Ariyapala Mask Museum

A must-see, which, with its dioramas and explanations, give an excellent insight into Sri Lankan masks and the meanings behind them. Delve into the mysterious world of dance, legend and exorcism, and the psychology behind the masks.
