Project itinerary

You will be working in an environment that has great need, but little support, and this will be a challenging but rewarding placement for you. To work in Ghana as a physiotherapy volunteer intern, you must either be qualified or at least in your second year of a university degree. The schedule, below, allows plenty of time for you to prepare for the day ahead, but also to relax and enjoy all that Ghana has to offer.

Mandatory Orientation Day

On the Monday of your first week at this location, you will join our orientation day to familiarise yourself with the surroundings, as well as local culture. Your program will continue as usual from Tuesday onward throughout the rest of the week.

Orientation Day Schedule

- Introduction meeting, House rules, Setting Expectations,
- Health and Safety Advice and handling of documents.
- Ghanaian Do's and Don'ts, Ghanaian Culture Lessons and
- Language Lessons. Tour around the local area
- Drive into Accra to visit the museum and craft market,
- Independence Square and Oxford street.
- Visit local shops and amenities.
